

## **GABRIEL FIGUEREDO MUSIC RECORD REVIEWS:**

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**ARTIST:** Tame Impala

**RECORD TITLE:** The Slow Rush

**"T**ame Impala" resurface, in early 2020, with the record: "The Slow Rush."

**A**ustralian "Kevin Parker" is still the central, creative force of band "Tame Impala," and he seems intent on reinventing the band's sound, yet again.

**M**ixing pop psychedelia, with the tempos of disco music, "The Slow Rush" is a slow burner for listeners looking to add something "different" to their record collection.

**E**ager fans will find the album presenting 12 songs: 4 "Noteworthy Songs" & 8 "Below Average Songs."

**"I**ntant Destiny" floats along softly, with vocals sounding soulful, and full of R'n'B charm.

**M**ost of the songs on "The Slow Rush," flow with mellow, laid-back, repetitive rhythms, and the listening experience becomes uninteresting fast, and underwhelming quite quickly.

**P**op sensibilities enter the equation on track "Is It True," and this track presents the most lively of tempos on the entire album.

**A**nother tune, that might intrigue "Tame Impala" fans, is the song "It Might Be Time," with its washes of simplistic drumbeats, and lightly-treading keyboards.

**L**yrically, "Kevin Parker" exclaims, "It Might Be Time To Face It," over-and-over again, and this statement provides the important "reality check:" this album is slow and sloppy, like an impala stuck in mud.

**A**lthough "The Slow Rush" lives up to its name, no one will be in a hurry to purchase this record anytime soon.
